2016 Union Plus Scholarship	Current & retired members of unions participating in any Union Plus Program, their spouses & their dependent children are eligible. Grandchildren are not eligible unless a legal dependent. At least one year of continuous union membership by the applicant, applicant's spouse. The applicant must be accepted into a US accredited college, university, community college, technical or trade school at the time the award is issued.	Deadline: January 31, 2016
Powered By Honor Community Commitment Scholarship	Be a member of Honor Credit Union and be the primary account holder at time of application and scholarship presentation, have been accepted at an accredited US post-secondary education institution, demonstrate academic achievement and community involvement and have a minimum GPA of 2.5.	Deadline: March 7, 2016
Plum Creek Community Scholarship	A high school senior who will be enrolling for the first time in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school for the entire upcoming academic year.	Deadline: January 27, 2016
MEA Scholarship	A high school graduate who will be attending a Michigan public community college, four-year degree-granting institution, or vocational training institution that grants a degree, certification or license.	Deadline: February, 25, 2016
The Bob Swanson Memorial Scholarship	High school senior actively participating in competitive tennis.	Deadline: January 8, 2016
AFSCME Family	Graduating high school senior who is a daughter or son of a full dues-paying AFSCME member or whose legal guardian or financially-responsible grandparent	Postmarked by:

Scholarship	is a full dues-paying AFSCME member, be accepted into a full-time degree program either at an accredited four-year institution or a two-year institution that will transfer credits to a four-year institution and have taken the SAT or the ACT.	December 31, 2015
The American Legion Department of Michigan Brewer Scholarship	Must be a son, daughter, grandchild or great-grandchild of a war-time veteran planning to attend any nationally accredited college or university. Selection is based on a student's GPA of 2.5 or higher, financial need, parent's or grandparent's honorable active war-time military service, goals and intentions.	Deadline: January 11, 2016
American Legion Auxiliary Children of Warriors National Presidents' Scholarship	Daughters, sons, grandsons, granddaughters, great-granddaughters, great-grandsons of veterans who served in the Armed Forces during eligibility dates for membership in The American Legion. Must be a high school senior and must complete 50 hours of volunteer service within the community during his/her high school years.	Deadline: March 1, 2016
American Legion Auxiliary Memorial Scholarship	Candidates shall be daughters, granddaughters, and great-granddaughters of any honorably discharged or deceased men/women veterans.	Postmarked by: March 15, 2016
American Legion Auxiliary Medical Scholarship	Candidates shall be daughters, granddaughters, great-granddaughters, sons, grandsons, great-grandsons, of honorably discharged or deceased men or women veterans. Scholarships restricted to students going into, or completing their senior year of high school and entering their first year of college who qualify and are in need of assistance.	Postmarked by: March 15, 2016
The American Legion Eagle Scout of the Year	The nominee must be a registered, active member of a Boy Scout Troop, Varsity Team, or Venturing Crew chartered to an American Legion post, American Legion Auxiliary unit or Sons of The American Legion squadron OR be a registered, active member of a chartered Boy Scout Troop, Varsity Scout Team, or Venturing Crew, and the son or grandson of a Legionnaire or Auxiliary member AND received the Eagle Scout Award, be an active member of his religious institution and must have received the appropriate Boy Scout religious emblem, have demonstrated practical citizenship in church, school, Scouting and community, have reached his 15 th birthday and be enrolled in high school at the time of selection, reside in the department to which he applies.	Deadline: March 1, 2016
The American Legion Department of Michigan Wilson Scholarship	Michigan residents who are attending high school and are a son, daughter, grandchild or great-grandchild of a war-time veteran planning to or are attending any Michigan accredited college or university. Selection is based on a student's GPA of 2.5 or higher, financial need, parent's or grandparent's honorable active war-time military service, goals and intentions.	Deadline: January 11, 2016
Truman D. Picard Scholarship	Native American students pursuing a higher education in Natural Resources.	Deadline: January 11, 2016
Anna L. Tobin Scholarship	Applicant must be planning to attend a non-profit school and plan to pursue a career in theater (or drama), music (instrumental or vocal), or dance. Candidates will be judges on performing arts background and interest, academic standing and citizenship, in said order.	Deadline: April 5, 2016

Bernadette Reider Scholarship	Applicant must be pursuing certification, or a degree at an institution of higher education in the field of nursing, financial need, 3.0 GPA or greater, involvement in extracurricular activities in the community, church, and/or school.	Deadline: April 5, 2016
Daniel Junak Memorial Fund Scholarship	Applicant must be planning to continue their education at a 2 year college, vocational school or certificate program and must have earned a minimum GPA of 2.0.	Deadline: April 5, 2016
Daryl T. Solomon	Applicant must be planning to pursue a post-secondary education with a History or Government major/History or Government Teaching and have a GPA of 3.0 or greater.	Deadline: April 5, 2016
Gordy Chinn Scholarship	Applicant must be planning to further his/her education.	Deadline: April 5, 2016
Hugo Kulju Memorial Scholarship	Graduating senior with plans to pursue a post-secondary education. Preference may be given to those entering teaching.	Deadline: April 5, 2016
Ishpeming Rotary Scholarship	Candidate must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.	Deadline: April 5, 2016
Joseph C. & Lois A. Hamel Scholarship	Candidate must have a minimum GPA of 2.0. Preference given to those who are pursuing a degree or certificate in an Industrial Technology vocation, leadership as demonstrated by participation in vocational classes at Westwood and financial need.	Deadline: April 5, 2016
National Mine School Alumni Scholarship	Graduating senior with plans to pursue a post-secondary education and must have a minimum GPA of 2.6.	Deadline: April 5, 2016
NICE Teachers' Association Scholarship	Graduating senior going on to post-secondary education. Points will be awarded in each of the following areas: Appropriately and accurately completed application, student essay, improvement or consistent performance in GPA throughout high school, demonstration of leadership qualities, extracurricular involvement and special talents or interests.	Deadline: April 5, 2016
Oddfellow Scholarship	Graduating senior with very low income and an interest in a Trade School type program.	Deadline: April 5, 2016
Paul M. Haapala Memorial Scholarship	Graduating senior who plans on furthering his/her education. The applicants will be judged on completeness and how well they meet the criteria (Character, Social Responsibility & Leadership, Work Ethic & Academic Achievement, and Personal Essay).	Deadline: April 5, 2016
Stuart L. Sundblad Memorial Scholarship	A senior who has been accepted as a full-time student at NMU. Student must have maintained a minimum GPA of 2.5 during high school. Recipient must not be receiving more than fifty percent of the tuition fees and costs from scholarships.	Deadline: April 5, 2016
TruNorth Federal Credit Union	Graduating senior, member of the TruNorth Federal Credit Union, and must have at least a 2.5 GPA.	Deadline: April 5, 2016
