The Marquette County Health Department will offer a Flu-shot clinic for the NICE Community Schools on **Thursday, November 21, 2019.**

The clinic is open to all students, staff & families. The target population is children from 6 months old and older.

GREAT NEWS! This year, the health department **CAN BILL INSURANCE.** If you have insurance that will cover the flu shot, we will need a copy of the card or the name of the company and the numbers of the insurance plan and group number. Without insurance, the cost for the flu-shot is only \$10 for students 18 and under and \$30 for adults. Please take advantage of this wonderful opportunity.

Students must have permission slip signed and returned to the school nurse by **Monday, November 18th.** Students without permission will not be vaccinated at school. The vaccines will be given on Thursday, November 21st from 9:00-11:00 a.m. at Aspen Ridge and 11:00- 11:30 a.m. at Westwood High School.

A flu-shot is recommended for everyone; including people with a chronic illness, i.e. Asthma, Diabetes, Heart Conditions, or anyone living with an infant or an elderly relative.
