SCHOOL MEAL PRICES

The cost for school lunch will be \$3.15 per day for all K-12 students. Breakfast will be \$1.95 per day. Lunches have increased by 5 cents per day as a result of a requirement from the federal government to ensure that sufficient funds are provided to the food service account for paid lunches. Reduced prices remain the same (30 cents for breakfast and 40 cents for lunch per day). Milk is included with each meal served but all students can purchase additional milk for 50 cents per carton.

(Breakfast will be available every day thereafter throughout the school year at each school)

Aspen Ridge School Breakfast begins at 7:45 a.m. & Westwood High School Breakfast begins at 7:30 a.m.

Parents are encouraged to use the **"SchoolPay" online option*** to pay for meals using a card or echeck. Student account histories showing purchases and balances are available through Family Access. Payments will still be accepted in the school office in check or cash. Students will have the same pin numbers as last year. *SchoolPay details are available on the district website.

In many cases, funding for programs and services in a district is based upon the free and reduced lunch count for that district. Please help us secure the maximum possible federal funding by completing a free or reduced lunch application form if you think you may qualify. You may fill out the form even if you do not plan to have your child take advantage of the school's lunch program.

FREE/REDUCED MEAL BENEFITS FROM LAST SCHOOL YEAR WILL END

Students and families who qualified for free or reduced price meals last school year (2019-2020) **MUST fill out a new application** for this school year (2020-2021) The free or reduced benefits from last year will only be carried-over until **Wednesday, October 14, 2020**. After that, if no new application is on file, meals will be begin to be charged at full price.
The school will not send a reminder or a notice of expired eligibility.

Applications will be sent home with each student on the first day of school or mailed to those students learning at home. They can also be picked up at each school office or downloaded and printed from the district website: www.nice.k12.mi.us.

To avoid an interruption of benefits, don't forget to re-apply for free or reduced price meals each school year!

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

If your family lives in any of the following situations:

- In a shelter
- In a motel or campground due to the lack of alternative adequate accommodation
- In a car, park, abandoned building, or bus or train station
- Doubled up with other people due to loss of housing or economic hardship

Your school-age children may qualify for certain rights and protections under the federal McKinney-Vento Act. Please contact the NICE Community School District Liaison, Becky Halamka, at (906) 485-1023 for assistance if you believe your children may be eligible.
