Digital Surveillance System with Licensing

The Proposal

The NICE Community School District is accepting bids for the purchase and installation of a replacement digital surveillance system at Aspen Ridge School and Westwood High School.

Bid Specifications

The digital surveillance system bid should be broken down by building and include the following:

1. Milestone Camera System is preferred.
2. Approximately 50 new vandal resistant cameras for Aspen Ridge School of which 38 would be replacing existing cameras and adding 12 to new locations. Of the approximately 50 new cameras, 35 will be indoors and 15 must be weather resistant for outdoor use. Not included in the previous totals, Aspen has 6 existing Milestone cameras that will need to be programmed into the new system, if possible.
3. Approximately 42 new vandal resistant cameras for Westwood High School of which 32 would be replacing existing cameras and adding 10 to new locations. Of the approximately 42 new cameras, 32 will be indoors and 10 must be weather resistant for outdoor use. Not included in the previous totals, Westwood has 19 existing Milestone cameras that will need to be programmed into the new system, if possible.
4. A digital video recorder or manager with a storage capacity of at least thirty (30) days for each building. The system must have the ability to choose a separate frame per second background recording rate versus the playback frame per second rate based on motion detection.
5. Licensing for the system.
6. Remote access through any computer connected to the internet.
7. Installation and all wiring and components necessary for operation of the system.
8. A list of all equipment to be installed with features and a cost per item, installation cost and a total system cost by building.
9. Expected installation timeline in June, July or August 2023.
10. Training and technical support provided.
11. Warranty and equipment information.
12. Annual maintenance service fee if any.
13. Service response time.
14. Name, address and phone number of at least three (3) references where a similar system has been installed.
15. A list of items, if any, the district would need to provide to make the system operational.

The district would prefer color cameras and the technology to retrieve court admissible video clips but these are not required. If your bid includes these preferences, the additional cost for these items should be listed separately in the bid.

Submission of Bid

Proposals must be hand delivered or mailed to the NICE Community School District Business Office, Attn: Bryan DeAugustine, Superintendent, 300 Westwood Drive, Ishpeming, MI 49849 by 2:00 pm on Thursday, May 11th, 2023 at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read. Bids must be sealed and clearly labeled "Surveillance System Bid".
